The woman who firefighters rescued from the house fire on Stockton Street on Friday, March 6, has died.

The Dallas County Medical Examiner's office identified the victim as Jennifer Alaine Correll, 41, of Burleson. She died Sunday, March 8, at 9:47 p.m. at Parkland Memorial Hospital in Dallas.

Burleson and Crowley firefighters responded to the call on Stockton Street at 3:55 p.m. on March 6. Light smoke was showing. Firefighters were told that there were people inside the home, but no one answered the door. Firefighters forced their way in the front door, made a quick stop on the fire, and rescued an adult female, later identified as Correll. CPR was performed on the 41-year-old woman before she was transported to Texas Health Huguley Hospital in Fort Worth. Correll was then flown to Parkland Memorial Hospital in Dallas, where she later died.

Burleson Fire Marshal Stacy Singleton and the Tarrant County Arson Task Force wrapped up the preliminary investigation of the structure fire shortly after midnight the morning of March 7. The fire started in the master bedroom. The second resident was not at the home when firefighters arrived. The cause is still under investigation, pending lab results.
