Save the date for the City's annual Arbor Day Celebration. It will take place on Friday, April 24, at 10 a.m. next to the BRiCK's outdoor pool in Bartlett Park. Second grade students from Frazier Elementary will be the guests of honor. Everyone who attends will get his or her choice of one free seedling - Live Oaks, Bur Oaks, Shumard Oaks, and Bald Cypress.

The year 2015 is the City of Burleson's 26<sup>th</sup> year as a designated Tree City USA. The Tree City USA program is a national program that provides the framework for community forestry management for cities and towns across America. Communities achieve Tree City USA status by meeting four standards of sound urban forestry management - maintaining a tree board or department, having a community tree ordinance, spending at least \$2 per capita on urban forestry and celebrating Arbor Day. Together the more than 3,400 Tree City USA communities serve as home to more than 135 million Americans.

The City's Arbor Day celebration takes place at Bartlett Park, home to the BRiCK, at 550 N.W. Summercrest Blvd. Access to the celebration will be from the BRiCK parking lot.
