Old Town Burleson isn't a venue just for Hot Sounds of Summer concerts anymore. The City and the Old Town Burleson Association are bringing back the old days of gathering to watch movies outdoors by hosting the free Old Town Picture Show on three consecutive Saturdays – Sept. 26, Oct. 3 and Oct. 10. Showtime is 8 p.m.

The movies include the original "Toy Story," (1995), on Sept. 26; "McFarland USA," a 2015 Disney movie, on Oct. 3; and "Willy Wonka and the Chocolate Factory," (1971), on Oct. 10.

"Toy Story" revolves around a little boy named Andy who loves playing with his toys, especially the cowboy doll named Woody. Andy's mother gives Andy an action figure, Buzz Lightyear, for his birthday. Buzz quickly becomes Andy's new favorite toy. Woody tries to get rid of Buzz, but the two toys get lost together and must find a way to get back to Andy before he moves without them.

"McFarland USA" is about a cross country coach in a predominantly Hispanic small California town who transforms a team of athletes into championship contenders. It is based on a true story about track coach Jim White, who is played by Kevin Costner. The teens are driven to succeed by their coach, strong family ties, work ethic and commitment to their team.

"Willy Wonka and the Chocolate Factory" is about a young boy named Charlie Bucket who wins a tour, led by the world's most unusual candy maker, through the most magnificent chocolate factory in the world. Willy Wonka hid five golden tickets in his chocolate Wonka bars, and the finders of those tickets were given a tour of the factory and a lifetime supply of chocolate. Gene Wilder plays the eccentric candy maker. The children include Charlie, Augustus Gloop, Veruca Salt, Violet Beauregarde and Mike Teavee.
