The SWAG Affair is back and it's going to be a full house at Chisenhall Fields Sports Complex Sept. 3.

The message at this free event, scheduled for 4 p.m.-8 p.m., is Sober – Wait – Awareness – Guidance. SWAG is hosted by the Burleson Municipal Court and Burleson city marshals. The court has partnered with K104.5 and K105.7 (104.5 is hip-hop and R&B and 105.7 is R&B), as well as First Financial Bank in Burleson.

This year's SWAG Affair includes a Kids Zone that's tailored to elementary school-age children. CareFlite will be landing a medical helicopter at the event, and the New Braunfels Police Department is bringing the DWI simulator.

City departments involved in the event include Environmental Services, Police Explorers, Fire Department, Fire Marshal, Library Teen Services, Mayor's Youth Council, Citizens on Patrol, the BRiCK, and Teen Court.
