An 89-year-old Burleson man whose vehicle was struck in a two-vehicle crash Friday night, died Sunday in a Fort Worth hospital. The man was identified by the Tarrant County Medical Examiner's Office as Joe Pace.

DATE/TIME OF CRASH: Friday, August 28, 2015, 9:03 p.m.
LOCATION: 1500 block of East Renfro Street, Burleson, TX

According to the crash investigator, a 2010 Chevrolet Camaro, driven by 54-year-old Jimmy Rogers of Burleson, was headed west in the 1500 block of East Renfro Street at the same time that a 2009 Honda Accord, driven by Pace, was headed east in the same block. This is a two-lane (one lane in each direction) state-maintained roadway in the city limits of Burleson.

The driver of the Camaro crossed over the center line into the eastbound lanes and struck the front left side of Pace's Accord. The crash occurred on Renfro Street, between Houston Road and Hidden Creek Parkway. The Camaro careened off the road and hit a building. Both drivers were transported by ground ambulance to Fort Worth hospitals.

On Sunday, Aug. 30, the medical examiner's office notified the police department that Pace had died at John Peter Smith Hospital at 8:18 p.m. on Aug. 30. The crash is still under investigation.
