A 36-year old Rendon woman died Sunday morning in a crash on I-35W in Burleson.

VICTIM: Autumn Leigh Rawlinson

DATE/TIME OF CRASH: Sunday, January 24, 2016, 10:04 a.m.

PLACE: 200 block of South I-35W, south of Renfro Street

Rawlinson was a passenger in a red 1994 GMC Sierra pickup driven by 47-year-old Paul Christopher McDonough of Cleburne. The second vehicle was a black 2008 Chevrolet Silverado pickup driven by a 67-year-old Burleson man. He had one passenger, a 34-year-old Burleson man.

According to the crash report, the black pickup was heading north in the right lane in the 200 block of South I-35W. The red pickup was directly behind the black pickup. The driver of the red pickup struck the black pickup from behind, pushing the black pickup head on in to the right guardrail. The red pickup spun back to the left, facing the wrong way in traffic. McDonough and Rawlinson were ejected. The red pickup finally came to a rest after the passenger side struck the left guard rail. The red pickup went over the guardrail and landed, facing south.

McDonough was transported to a Fort Worth hospital via Care Flite Air Ambulance. Rawlinson was pronounced dead at the scene at 10:17 a.m. The occupants of the black pickup did not report injuries.

The northbound lanes of I-35W were closed for five hours.
