UPDATE: Carroll West was located by the Galveston Police Department shortly before midnight on May 1. Galveston Police medically cleared him and his family was contacted.

The public's assistance is needed in locating Carroll West. He is a 75-year-old Burleson man, 5-feet-7-inches tall, weighing approximately 132 pounds, with gray hair and hazel eyes. He was last seen wearing an orange t-shirt, blue jeans, and brown boots. Mr. West has scars on his chest and neck.

He was last seen at 4 p.m. today, May 1, in Clute, Texas. He was driving a silver 2012 Chevrolet Colorado pickup with a Texas license plate of 01J5261.

Mr. West has been diagnosed with a cognitive impairment. Law enforcement officials believe that his disappearance poses a credible threat to his own health and safety.

He left his Burleson home on Saturday, April 30, en route to Clute to visit the neighbor of a friend who had died. The neighbor in Clute said Mr. West was traveling north on State Hwy. 288 when he was last seen at 4 p.m. today.
