The City of Burleson Public Works Department will begin the annual mill and overlay program on July 25, 2016. This consists of removing and replacing 2 inches of pavement on selected asphalt streets in the City. The following streets will be impacted by this year's program:

- Irene St. - Hidden Creek Pkwy. to Steven St.
- Arnold Ave. – Steven St. to Concrete Transition (just past Vaden Ave.)
- Vaden Ave. – Arnold St. to 1050 Vaden (phase transition)
- Sundown Trl. – N.W. Summercrest to N.W. Wintercrest
- Sundown Cr. – Sundown Trl. to Court
- S.W. Wilshire Ext. – McNairn to Dead End (Suzanne Terr.)
- Springhill Dr. – Parkridge Blvd. to 949 Springhill Dr. (phase transition)
- Aspen Cr. – Live Oak Ln. to Court
- Oak Valley Rd. – Parkridge Blvd. to 933 Oak Valley Rd. (approximately 300')

There will be a door hanger (see sample below) placed on the front door of every address that will be impacted directly by this operation 48 to 72 hours prior to the work starting on your street. Additionally, if you are registered to receive notification calls from our Everbridge communication system, you will receive a call 48 to 72 hours prior to the work starting and again the day before the work is scheduled. Additional door hangers or phone calls may be necessary if there is a weather or mechanical delay to the project, so please be watchful for these notifications. Finally, the information will be posted on Facebook and Twitter including any changes due to delays.

This maintenance project will start on Irene, Arnold and Vaden on July 25, 2016. Please do not park on the street during this operation. Vehicles left on the street will be subject to towing either onto the available driveway or to the nearest cross street to allow for continuous mill and overlay operations. Any towing needed will delay the completion of this project and impact open access to and from your property.

If you live within the affected section(s) of roadway, the contractor will work with you to allow access to and from your driveway as needed. Some delays may occur depending on what part of the operation the contractor is in at the time. Please notify the City if you have any special needs, i.e., home health care access to your home, important or critical deliveries during the project time frame, etc.

Please keep in mind that the placement of asphalt takes longer than removal; therefore, additional door hangers and notifications may be required to keep you informed as to the dates asphalt work will start on your street. It is our plan to minimize this time gap as much as humanly possible.
