Old Town Burleson isn't a venue just for Hot Sounds of Summer concerts anymore. The City of Burleson and Hayes & Stolz Manufacturing Co. are bringing back the old days of gathering to watch movies outdoors by hosting the free Old Town Picture Show on three consecutive Saturdays – Sept. 17, Sept. 24 and Oct. 1. Showtime is 8 p.m.

The movies include “Miracles from Heaven,” (2016), on Sept. 17; “Inside Out,” a 2015 Disney movie, on Sept. 24; and “Star Wars: The Force Awakens,” (2015), on Oct. 1.

The fun kicks off at 6 p.m. on Sept. 17 with a special pre-show concert featuring Christian Rock group The Austin Tullos Band, and book signing by “Miracles from Heaven” author and Burleson area resident Christy Beam.

“Miracles from Heaven” is based on the incredible true story of the Beam family. When Christy (Jennifer Garner) discovers her 10-year-old daughter Anna (Kylie Rogers) has a rare, incurable disease, she becomes a ferocious advocate for her daughter's healing as she searches for a solution. After Anna has a freak accident, an extraordinary miracle unfolds in the wake of her dramatic rescue that leaves medical specialists mystified, her family restored and their community inspired.

“Inside Out” centers around Riley, who is uprooted from her Midwest life when her father starts a new job in San Francisco. Like all of us, Riley is guided by her emotions - Joy, Fear, Anger, Disgust and Sadness. The emotions live in Headquarters, the control center inside Riley's mind, where they help advise her through everyday life. As Riley and her emotions struggle to adjust to a new life in San Francisco, turmoil ensues in Headquarters. Although Joy, Riley's main and most important emotion, tries to keep things positive, the emotions conflict on how best to navigate a new city, house and school.

“Star Wars: The Force Awakens” takes place thirty years after the Galactic Empire vanquished, when a new threat rises. The First Order attempt to rule the Galaxy and only a small bunch of heroes have the ability to stop them. Meanwhile, a female scavenger named Rey teams up with a rogue stormtrooper to return a droid to the resistance base containing a map to a legendary Jedi Master.
