City looks to fill open Board and Commission seats

The city is accepting applications until Nov. 28 for vacant seats on the Animal Shelter Advisory Committee, Building Codes, Planning and Zoning Commission and Standards Board and Old Town Development Standards Review Committee.

The city is accepting applications until Nov. 28 for vacant seats on the Animal Shelter Advisory Committee, Building Codes, Planning and Standards Board, Zoning Commission and Old Town Development Standards Review Committee

The Animal Shelter Advisory Committee open seat is for the youth member position, applicants must be 13-17 years-old and reside within the city limits of Burleson.

There are currently five positions open on the Building Codes and Standards Board. Place 4 requires applicants to be a licensed plumber and Burleson resident, Place 7 requires a heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) license and places 8 & 9 are alternate positions that require the applicant to be a licensed plumber, electrician or have a HVAC license.

Place 2 on the Old Town Development Standards Review Committee is currently vacant and is a youth member seat. Applicants must be 13 – 17 years-old and reside within the city limits. Place 6 is vacant and requires the applicant to either be a resident of Burleson or to own a business in Old Town.

The Planning and Zoning Commission is looking to fill Place 6, all applicants must reside within the city limits.

All open seats will serve for a two-year term, from 2016 through 2018.

Board and Commission members are appointed by City Council. The open positions are expected to be appointed at the Dec. 12 City Council meeting.
