A bond has been set against Tristan Torres, accused of fatally shooting a 17-year-old and injuring another.

Bond was set at \$250,000 for the murder of Cameron Lewis and \$100,000 for aggravated assault against Lewis' twin brother.

The shooting occurred around 11 p.m. Saturday, April 22 in the 200 block of SW Thomas St. Preliminary reports indicate the suspect and victims were meeting to fight and randomly selected the campus of Burleson ISD's Mound Elementary school as that meeting location. Investigators are still working to determine the motive for the altercation and are currently speaking with multiple witnesses.

The suspect is said to have stopped his car in the 300 block of NW Tarrant and shot from the driver's seat out of the passenger window. The distance from the suspect's car to the victim's car was approximately 100 yards. The victim was sitting on the driver's side of the vehicle when he was shot, and his twin brother was standing next to the vehicle. Investigators have determined that there were several shots fired from a .40 caliber semi-automatic pistol. At the time of Torres' arrest, he informed detectives of the gun's location. Police have recovered the gun.

Torres is an 18-year-old Burleson High School senior. Both the victims were former BHS students.
