**June 17 is Election Day for Place 4 runoff**

*Voters will have one last opportunity to cast a ballot in local elections during Election Day, Saturday, June 17.*

Voters will have one last opportunity to cast a ballot in the runoff election for Place 4 on the Burleson City Council during Election Day, Saturday, June 17. Polls will open at 7 a.m. and remain open until 7 p.m. All voting takes place at in the Council Chambers at Burleson City Hall, 141 W. Renfro St.

Burleson voters will have their choice between candidates Pam Grant Tatum and Todd Hulsey. Place 4, like all Burleson City Council seats, are elected at-large for three-year terms.

At the May 6 general election, three candidates were vying for the Place 4 seat currently held by Matt Aiken, who chose not to run for reelection. Tatum garnered 38.27 percent of the vote and Hulsey received 42.73 percent. In order to win the seat outright, the person with the highest number of votes would have had to earn 50 percent of the total vote, plus one. Shannan Sutter received 19 percent of the votes for Place 4.

If you did not vote in the May 6 election, you can still vote in the June 17 runoff election. All you need to vote is picture identification – (Department of Public Safety issued) driver's license, Texas Identification card, Election ID certificate, or concealed handgun license; (Department of Defense issued) Uniformed Service ID (active or retired), DOD Civilian Retiree, or Common Access Card – Civilian worker residing on military base; United States passport; or United States Certificate of Citizenship.
