

Natatorium Rules

1. Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by a parent or responsible person in a swim suit at all times, including in the water, on the deck and in the restrooms. While in the lap pool, the parent or responsible person must remain within arms reach of the child.
2. Walk; don't run in or around the pool facility.
3. Candy, food or beverages are not allowed, except in designated areas provided for eating and drinking (party rooms or sundeck). No glass items, chewing gum, chewing tobacco, smoking, or electronic cigarettes are tolerated anywhere in the facility.
4. Foul or abusive language will not be tolerated. Respect will be shown to all patrons and pool safety staff. Failure to do so will result in time out of pool and/or dismissal from the facility.
5. Acceptable swim attire must be worn by patrons on the deck and in the water. Swim shirts or rash guards are permitted, as they are made out of swimsuit material. Cut-off shorts and underwear/undergarments are not acceptable swim attire.
6. Infants and toddlers must wear swim diapers covered by an appropriate swim suit.
7. The last ten minutes of every hour is break time. Anyone under the age of 18 will exit the pool until break is over. Children must be supervised.
8. Diving, back dives, somersaults and/or any other unsafe activity is not permitted. If the pool safety staff deems an activity unsafe, patrons will be asked to discontinue the act.
9. Inflatable floats or "water wings" are not allowed in the swimming pool. Only coast guard approved floatation vests and devices are allowed. Lifejackets for small children are available at the guard shack.
10. Swimmers requiring the use of the lifejackets are not allowed in water deeper than 3FT unless accompanied by a capable adult swimmer.
11. Do not hang on lane ropes.
12. Patrons must shower before entering the pool.
13. Animals are not allowed in the building or pool area, with the exception of guide dogs. Guide dogs are allowed on deck, but not in the water.
14. No one should engage the lifeguards or pool safety staff in unnecessary conversation or activity.
15. Dispose of all trash in trash receptacles.
16. The pool safety staff reserves the right to implement any rules and policies as needed for the safety and comfort of our guests. Patrons that do not follow verbal instruction from staff will be asked to leave the swimming area.

Natatorium Water Slide Rules

1. All sliders must be at least 48 inches tall. The dispatcher will turn away all others.
2. Only one person on the slide at a time. Younger children may not ride with their parents.
3. Slide feet first only, on back. Keep hands and feet inside the slide.
4. No Stopping, turning, standing, kneeling or rotating.
5. Tank Tops, t-shirts, rash guards, or swim shirts are prohibited.
6. Lifejackets and Puddle Jumpers are prohibited.

7. Goggles and glasses are prohibited.
8. Start slide when directed by dispatcher.
9. Exit receiving pool immediately.
10. Only 8 people are permitted on the tower at one time- one on each landing and one at the top.
11. Keep the line against the wall.
12. If the tower rules are not maintained or if anyone creates a disturbance in the line they will be denied its use by the pool safety staff.
13. Women who are or may be pregnant may use slide at their own risk.

Outdoor Pool Rules

1. All patrons entering the outdoor pool area are required to pay the facility admissions fee, including swimmers, non-swimmers and spectators.
2. Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by a parent or responsible person, in a swim suit, at all times including in the water, on the deck and in the restroom. While in the water, the parent or responsible person must remain within arm reach of the child.
3. Walk; don't run in and around the pool area.
4. Candy, food or beverages are not allowed except in designated areas provided for eating and drinking. No glass items, chewing gum, chewing tobacco, smoking, or electronic cigarettes are tolerated anywhere in the facility.
5. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
6. Foul or abusive language will not be tolerated. Respect will be shown to all patrons and pool safety staff. Failure to do so will result in time sat out or dismissal from the facility.
7. Acceptable swim attire must be worn by patrons on the deck and in the water. Swim shirts or rash guards are permitted, as they are made out of swimsuit material. Cut-off shorts and underwear/undergarments are not acceptable swim attire.
8. Infants and toddlers must wear swim diapers covered by an appropriate swim suit.
9. The last ten minutes of every hour is break time. Anyone under the age of 18 years old will exit the pool until break is over. Children must be supervised.
10. Diving in water less than five feet deep, back dives, somersaults and "cannon balls" from the side of the pool or any other unsafe activities are not permitted. The pool safety staff deems an activity unsafe, patrons will be asked to discontinue the act.
11. Inflatable floats or "water wings" are not allowed in the swimming pool. Only coast guard approved floatation vests are allowed, lifejackets are available at the pool office.
12. Swimmers requiring the use of the lifejackets are not allowed in water deeper than 3FT unless accompanied by a capable adult swimmer.
13. Animals are not allowed in the building or pool area, with the exception of guide dogs. Guide dogs are allowed on deck, but not in the water.
14. No one should engage the lifeguards in unnecessary conversation or activity.
15. Dispose of all trash in trash receptacles.
16. Patrons must shower before entering pool.

17. Diving Board Rules: One swimmer at a time on the diving board. No t-shirts, rash guards, swim shirts, goggles, or glasses are permitted. Diver must exit diving area before the next person may jump.
18. Staff reserves the right to implement any rules and policies as needed for the safety and comfort of our guests. Patrons that do not follow verbal instruction from staff will be asked to leave the swimming area.
