

Book Page Wreath



Supplies Needed:

75 ish old book pages-I used paperback pages.

Cardboard- enough for an 8-12 inch circle.

Ribbon for hanging – 20 inches

Center ornament, bow, fancy box, or whatever you have.

Stapler & staples

Hot glue gun, craft glue

Scissors

Compass

Roll a single book page into a cone. Staple the end about $\frac{3}{4}$ inch from tip. Repeat with the remaining pages.

Use the compass to draw a circle on the cardboard, 8 to 12 inches in diameter. Then draw another circle in the center about half the size. Cut out the larger circle. The center circle is your guideline for the layers of cones.

Attach the hanging ribbon to the top back of the cardboard circle.

If you plan to have your wreath hanging where the back will be seen, use more book pages to cover it.

With tips facing inwards, hot glue four cones at the north, south, east, & west points, using the circle as a guide for tip placement. Fill in between those cones until the first layer is complete.

Repeat for the 2nd layer with the tips almost in the middle.

Arrange ornament or fancy item in the center and hot glue it.

Done!!
