***Voting Information – by County***

**Johnson County Voters**

Early Voting starts October 13, 2020 at 8:00am.

***Where do I go to Early Vote?***

All early voting for the City of Burleson will be at the Burleson Sub-Courthouse ONLY in Johnson County.

247 Elk Dr. Room 104 – Across the street from Burleson High School.

***Will I get one ballot or two?***

You will receive two paper ballots, one for Federal, State and County elections and a separate ballot for the City of Burleson election.

You will qualify for the Federal, State and County election separate from the City election. You will need to show your ID twice because there are two different table for the ballots. Make sure you receive two ballots or ask how you will get the two ballots.

***What if I vote and only get one ballot but I live in the City of Burleson?***

Ask one of the helpful Johnson County election clerks for your city ballot.

***Can I go to another Johnson County early voting location?***

No. Early voting for the city election is only at the Burleson Sub-Courthouse. Johnson County will have other voting locations but city is only at the Burleson Sub-Courthouse.
