Where Do I Take My Household Hazardous Waste?

Residents of Burleson can take their household hazardous waste to the Environmental Collection Center (ECC) in Fort Worth.

There is no fee for dropping off your household hazardous waste, however, residents must take a City of Burleson water or solid waste bill as proof of residency. Business, commercial and industrial waste cannot be accepted under Texas regulations.
