CONNECT WITH ELECTED OFFICIALS

Egrets and Herons are federally protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act of 1918. What this means is the birds cannot be killed, or their nests disturbed when they have eggs or young. Egrets and Herons come together and make a “rookery” which can be made up of a few dozen birds to thousands of birds.
