Basketball Gym Rules

The gymnasium is available for open recreation at all times with exception to facility rentals and the Monday Night Adult Basketball League.

No dunking is allowed during open play. Dunking is only allowed during league play.

Appropriate athletic attire is required. Shirts and non-marking athletic shoes must be worn at all times. Recreation staff may deem what is considered appropriate.

No food, drinks, or chewing gum are allowed in the gym. Water is the only exception.

Fitness Area (Upstairs) Rules

Although the fitness area is supervised, members exercise at their own risk.

Appropriate athletic attire is required. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times. Recreation staff may deem what is

Slamming or dropping of the weight stacks or free weights is prohibited.

considered appropriate.

No food, drinks or chewing gum are allowed in the fitness area. Water is the only exception.

Please do not move or alter any equipment. No equipment shall leave the weight room at any time.

Please do not rest or sit on equipment between sets. Allow other members to "work in".

When crowded, please limit time on the cardiovascular equipment to 25 minutes.

If you are unsure of the use of the equipment, please ask an attendant for a demonstration.

General BRiCK Facility

Participants, must check in at the kiosk desk with *their BRiCK membership I.D. card.*

A membership card or photo I.D. must be exchanged for balls or equipment. Participants are responsible for the return and care of any equipment checked out in their name.

For your health, the BRiCK is an alcohol, drug, and tobacco-free environment.

All individuals must wear a shirt, pants, & shoes while in the BRiCK lobby.

Inappropriate behavior, abusive language, unsportsmanlike conduct, or misuse of equipment may result in participants' dismissal from the center.

The BRiCK is not responsible for lost or stolen property.

Weapons and firearms are prohibited.

BRiCK staff reserves the right to determine all facility use.

Destruction or misuse of City property may result in permanent expulsion from the center, fines or recover damages of equipment/property, and a report to the Burleson Police. This facility is being monitored and recorded through video surveillance.

Participants are expected to follow all rules associated with each area of the BRiCK.

It is mandatory that all children under the age of 10 be supervised by an adult at all times.

Rockwall/Boulder Rules

Children under the age of 14 must either have adult supervision or be a participant in a Burleson Recreation Center program.

A shirt, pants, and shoes must be worn. No barefoot climbing. No swim suits permitted.

The BRiCK reserves the right to expel any participant judged unsafe or objectionable to other customers.

Never climb underneath another climber.

Topping out on the rock is not allowed.

Running and unsupervised roaming are not permitted.

Rentals are available for the use of ropes and harnessing equipment.

Late Policy:

1st time late - Verbal Warning

2nd time late - \$5 fee for every five min. late

Children are allowed to stay a maximum of 2 hours per visit.

No outside toys or electronic devices will be permitted.

Children are welcome to bring a snack or drink. Please no nut related products.

Parents and guardians must be in the BRiCK building at all times.

Memberships

Family: A family consists of two (2) adults and all tax-dependent children and/or tax-dependent relatives living in the same household. Individuals must be able to provide proof of permanent residency at the same household and proof of tax-dependent children and/or tax-dependent relatives.

Accepted proof of tax-dependent children and/or tax-dependent relatives: A current tax return statement

Accepted proof of permanent residency: A current water bill and drivers licenses

Membership and Family Membership Renewals: Patron must provide proof of residency at time of renewal. Patron must provide proof of residency and proof of tax-dependent children and/or tax-dependent relatives at the time of renewal.

Refund Policy

Annual Membership Passes are **non-refundable**, with the exception of the 30-day Opt Out Period which allows Annual and/or EFT Contract membership holders 30 days from the date of purchase to cancel the membership. Service charges may apply.

Annual Membership Passes are **transferable**. Annual Pass holders may transfer their pass to another individual or family.

Natatorium Rules

No glass containers.

No food or drinks in the natatorium.

Proper swimming attire required. Cut-off or frayed shorts and other clothing are not allowed. T-shirts are not allowed in the swimming pool.

No hanging on pool ropes.

No talking to lifeguards while they are on stands.

Gum chewing is prohibited.

Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.

No smoking in the pool and pool areas.

Swimmers requiring the use of lifejackets are not allowed in water deeper than 3ft unless accompanied by a capable adult swimmer.

Staff reserves the right to implement any rules and policies as needed for the safety and comfort of our customers.

Inflatable floats or "water wings" are not allowed in the swimming pool.

Only Coast Guard approved floatation vests are allowed.

Complimentary life jackets are available at the pool office.

All water aerobics classes are complimentary with your membership!
